Killed - 26
Wounded - 3

The Korean Army confiscated 3 Japanese rifles and lost 2 light machine guns, 6 M-1's and 7 carbines. (C-3)

CHEJU-DO

(1) National Police report the following recapitulation of police actions on CHEJU-DO during the period 24 February to 7 March:

Rebel casualties: Killed - 98
Captured - 64

Police captured 1 carbine, 1 Japanese rifle, and many leftist documents.

(2) Results of Korean Army action CHEJU-DO for period 10-12 March follow:

Rebel casualties: Killed - 22
Captured - 16
Korean Army casualties: Killed - 2
Wounded - 2

The Korean Army recovered 1 M-1 rifle, 3 carbines, and 8 Japanese rifles. (B-2)

COMMENT: The relatively small number of arms confiscated by security forces, as compared to the number of rebels killed or captured, is a good indication of the comparatively few weapons possessed by rebels on CHEJU-DO.

b. Civil Unrest

Weekly Violence Summarized

A recapitulation of rebel activities for the period 11-18 March follows: (See map, Incl #2)

(1) 10-12 Mar - CHEJU-DO. Korean Army operations report. Twenty-two rebels and 2 soldiers killed. Sixteen rebels captured, and 2 soldiers wounded. One M-1 rifle, 3 carbines and 8 Japanese rifles were recovered by army. (B-2)

c. Delayed Reports That Have Not Been Previously Summarized (See P/R #1082)

(5) 5 Mar - SANGHWAJON (930-1130), CHEJU-DO. Security Forces meet rebels in 2 engagements. Three rebels killed and 32 rebels captured. (C-2)

(6) 6 Mar - KWANGU SA TEMPLE (950-1140), CHEJU-DO. Security Forces raid rebel hide-out. Five rebels killed and 20 captured. (C-2)

(7) 7 Mar - AEMOL-Li (930-1140), CHEJU-DO. Police and Korean Army attack rebels. Two rebels, 2 soldiers, and 1 civilian killed. Ten rebels captured. (C-2)
