Reference WX 89039, ourads ZGBI 1268 and 1360, and ZPOL 1301, the following answers questions set forth in WX 89039:

1A. Communists knew that they were voting to sustain North Korean elections; others (presumably moderates) voted as means toward unification; still others voted under duress, through ignorance, because of promise of reward or a reward. Duress was used on Cheju and in some of southern provinces; on Ongjin Peninsula 3 Dai Dong (right wing) party members signed a paper when they were told they would receive land. Forgery was perhaps most widespread means of marking ballots in South Korea.

Section 1. South Korea.

-Subversive:

1. Communist violence during the period included 1 Rightist killed. Delayed reports disclosed a renewal of guerilla activities on Cheju-Do. Between 15-18 September 1948, 5 persons were killed by raiders. Raiders also abducted and intimidated villagers in an apparent effort to increase their prestige or demonstrate their power. One police box was fired upon but no damage resulted. On 1 October trouble broke out again between the police and Communists.

No reports were received concerning Rightist-inspired violence.

A summary of facts of violence on part of persons of unknown political affiliation include one assassination and one attack on an individual.

2. Communists are increasing their activities of propogandizing, recruiting and reorganizing. Additional dates for scheduled Communist riots and uprisings continue to be received. Seven reports, A, B and C, cite October and 2 tie the riots in with action by the United Nations on the Korean question. On 1 and 6 October Communists on Cheju Do struck again at security forces. Seven police were killed, several wounded, 1 constabularyman killed and four wounded. The constabulary
