2. Raiders continued to be active on Cheju Do and to be rounded up by the constabulary. During this period it was reported that 2 towns were attacked, 50 Rightists killed, 30 Communists killed and a delayed summary for the period 11-26 Nov lists a total of 167 Communists killed.

5. Communist violence, including all reports except those for Yosu, Taegu, Naju and Kangwon Do, total 2 attacks on towns, 1 attack on police, 50 Rightist killed, 30 Communists killed (all on Cheju Do), 3 attacks on Rightist, 2 acts of sabotage, 2 labor strikes and 1 school strike. Delayed reports list 167 Communists killed, and 2 attacks on Rightist. No Rightist-inspired acts of violence were reported. Three individuals were attacked by persons of unknown political affiliation during the period and a delayed report lists 1 such attack on 18 Nov.
